- ◇ John 1:1-5 Jesus as the eternal Word and true Light seen again in John 8:12.
- ◇ Genesis 1:1-5 God's first act of creation was to bring light into darkness—pointing to Jesus, the Light who brings spiritual life.
- ◇ Exodus 13:20-24, 33:7-11 Numbers 14:14 God's presence as light in the wilderness foreshadows Jesus as the Light of the World, dwelling with His people.

Jesus Is the Light That Leads to Life (vv. 12–20)

Truth: Jesus alone is *the* _____ of the world, sent from the _____ to _____ God and to _____ and _____ us from the darkness of _____ into eternal life.

Application: Because He is the true light, we must follow Him daily—**trusting in him, not relying on our own wisdom or the world's false lights.**

A Warning Against Unbelief (vv. 21–30)

Truth: To _____ Jesus is to remain in _____ and face eternal separation and _____ from God; only by _____ that He is God “I AM” and lifted up for our sin on the cross can we be saved.

Application: Because unbelief has eternal consequences, we must respond in faith now—children, teens, and adults alike—by trusting Jesus fully and not delaying.
