

Bible Reading for this week:

- ◇ Ezekiel 34:1–16 This passage exposes Israel's false shepherds and shows God's promise to personally shepherd His people .
- ◇ Psalm 23:1–6 David's psalm pictures the same relationship Jesus describes — a Shepherd who knows, provides for, and leads his sheep to abundant life. .
