Bible Reading for this week:

- ◇ Isaiah 40:1–5 This prophecy establishes God's promise of comfort and a coming forerunner, the foundation for understanding why John's birth matters.
- ◇ Psalm 130 This psalm echoes the longing and patient hope of God's people during the centuries of silence, trusting that the Lord will redeem.
- ◇ 1 Samuel 1:1–20 Hannah's story mirrors the theme of God bringing life from barrenness, foreshadowing how He works through unlikely beginnings.
- ◇ Jeremiah 33:14–16 This promise of a righteous Branch reminds us that God never abandons His covenant and always moves toward redemption in His time.
- ◇ Mark 1:1–8 This passage shows Isaiah's promise fulfilled as John steps onto the stage, preparing the way for the Lord's arrival.

TODAYS SERMON:

Our Long Awaited Savior: Promise in the Silence

Luke 1:5-25, Isaiah 40:1-5

A Faithful Remnant in Dark Times (vv.5-7)

Truth: God preserves and works through those who remain faithful even when He seems silent.

Application: Continue walking in daily obedience, trusting that the Lord is active even when His timing feels slow.

A Messenger Long Foretold (vv. 8-17)

Truth: God fulfills His promises with precision, preparing the way for His saving work just as He declared through the prophets.

Application: Lean on Scripture with confidence, knowing every promise God has spoken will come to pass.

God Moves When His People Least Expect It (vv.18-22)

Truth: The Lord often brings His greatest work when circumstances appear impossible

Application: Bring doubts and discouragement to Him while choosing to trust that He is moving beyond what you can see.

Preparing Our Hearts for the Savior (vv. 23-25)

Truth: God brings life to barren places and invites His people to be ready for the Savior's transforming work.

Application: Open your heart to His renewing power by surrendering areas of weariness, fear, or disappointment.
