Bible Reading for the Week

- ◇ Isaiah 46:9–13 God declares his absolute sovereignty over history, assuring us that his saving purposes will stand just as he promised.
- ◇ Micah 5:2–5 God foretells the humble birthplace and shepherd-king role of the Messiah, showing that Jesus' coming was planned long before it happened.
- ◇ Isaiah 52:7–10 This passage celebrates the announcement of salvation and peace, echoing the angelic good news proclaimed at Jesus' birth.
- ◇ Romans 5:1–11 Paul explains how peace with God comes through faith, fulfilling the promise of peace declared by the angels.
