

### Bible Reading for this week: THE WAY, THE TRUTH, THE LIFE\*

Jesus provides for us as much as we need to know and can know about God. "No one has ever seen God. It is God the only Son, who is close to the Father's heart, who has made him known" (1:18 NRSV).

- **He is the WAY: John 1:18; 8:36; 10:9; Colossians 1:15.**— Jesus is both God and man, knowing intimately our experience and our needs. He is our path, bridge, transport—not just an example or road sign. He is our guide with dependable directions and powerful protection. Our personal relationship with Christ links us to God. Our response should be to follow his guidance, trusting his ability to do for us what we cannot do for ourselves.
- **He is the TRUTH: John 1:14, 17; 5:19; 8:29.**— Jesus is our source of intimate knowledge of the Father. His answers, teaching, and commands were right. No shadow of dishonesty, falsehood, or lying was in his life. He is the reality of all God promised. Our response should be to believe in him and put into practice what he taught.
- **He is the LIFE: John 1:4; 3:15; 5:26; 10:10; 11:25.**— Jesus gives us life both now and eternally. His life provides the surest model for our own. He promises to join his life to ours. There is no other source of life beside him. Our response should be to receive that life and allow it to work itself out in our daily experience.

**TODAYS SERMON:  
Jesus is the way, the truth and the life**

*February 7, 2026*

**John 14:1-14**

**Don't be troubled, Jesus is our source of peace and promises.  
(vv. 1-4)**

Truth: Since Jesus has already accomplished our \_\_\_\_\_ and prepared our \_\_\_\_\_, believers can securely rest in trust in him. .

Application: Because Jesus has already secured your place with the Father, you do not have to live in fear or uncertainty in a broken world. Trusting Him means resting today in promises that are already accomplished, even when circumstances feel unsettled.

**Believing in (knowing) Jesus is the only way to come to and know God (vv. 5-11)**

Truth: Only by \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ in Jesus Christ can anyone truly \_\_\_\_\_ God and be \_\_\_\_\_ to him.

Application: Knowing God is not found through religion, or sincerity, but through a living relationship with Jesus himself. When you trust Christ, you are not merely learning about God—you are transformed by him and reconciled to Him.

**Believing in Jesus includes continuing the work of Jesus  
(vv. 12-14)**

Truth: True belief in Jesus always results in a life that continues his \_\_\_\_\_ through faithful \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_.

Application: True faith moves beyond belief into obedient participation in Christ's mission through the power of the Holy Spirit. As you ask, serve, and live for kingdom purposes, God works through you to bring lasting fruit that glorifies the Father.
