Going deeper - Bible Reading for this week:

- ◇ Acts 1:4–11 This connects directly to Jesus' promise of the Spirit and the call to be His witnesses, showing that divine power is essential for Kingdom mission.
- ◇ Acts 4:23–31 The early church prayed for boldness under persecution and was filled with the Spirit, illustrating dependence on God amid opposition and trouble.
